#### RULES AND CONDITIONS

- P.C.A.Q. rules apply at all Events
- Code of Conduct PCAQ and Redlands Horse and Pony Club Code of Conduct will be in effect. Bad language, excessive striking of horse, abuse or disrespect to the judge will result in disqualification
- Protests should be lodged within 30 minutes of results being posted, or the incident and be accompanied by a \$20.00 fee which is refundable only if the protest is upheld
- Show jumping grading cards must be handed to the secretary before 8:00 a.m. when collecting back numbers
- 12 years and under riders may ride a graded or UN graded horse but should enter only a horse they normally ride at Pony Club. No performance card is required.
- Riders in grades A, B, C, D, Pony & Galloway must be 13 years or older and have a performance card which must be presented when collecting back numbers Ponies and Galloway's must not exceed 15 hands. Riders may choose either Pony and Galloway or a Graded Class but cannot compete in both at the same fixture. Starting heights for Pony & Galloway is 90cm, going to a maximum height of 1.1m. If insufficient entries, P & G may be run in conjunction with D Grade, scored on a separate sheet. Height in this case will stop at 1.1m for P & G
- Riders may have one competitive horse in the Official section and one competitive horse in the Unofficial (or Height) Section. A rider competing on one horse in the graded/official classes may not ride another graded horse in unofficial classes below 80cm **OR** Riders may have two horses in the official section, one competitive and one ridden HC, the HC horse to be ridden second **OR** Riders may have two horses in the unofficial (or height) section, one competitive and one HC, the HC horse to be ridden second. The horse to be ridden HC must be nominated as such on the entry form
- P.C.A.Q. requires that all riders produce their "P.C.A.Q. Rider Identification Card" on the day of competition. This is in addition to grading cards where applicable to the class entered. The P.C.A.Q. Rider ID card Number must be included on the event nomination form.
- RHPC would appreciate assistance for the day to assist with rails and course changes.
- The organizing committee will not accept any responsibility for any contingency plans put in place as a result of any Exotic Disease Outbreak.
- Nomination Fees will be refunded in the event of the cancellation of this event should Department of Primary Industries and Fisheries Event Protocol or other Movement Restrictions change.
